Every November in Texas during Veteran's Day weekend we have brought our wounded veterans and their children from Fort Sam Houston into Kemah to enjoy three days and nights of fun-filled activities where they are provided with an all-expense paid stay that includes, meals, drinks, amusement park rides, local musical entertainment, fireworks, a huge military display of vehicles, the Golden Knights and All Veterans Parachute teams, luncheon cruise on the gulf of Mexico, all with military guest speakers, the Mayor, an Army swearing-in ceremony and a variety of military booths full of helpful information for our military guests and members of the public.
